

### **Make your own films - kids from all over the world discover film**

Young filmmakers present their works to an expert jury and a large audience. They show what is important to them: friendship, future, environment, but also bullying, migration, courage and fear. From September 19-23, 2018 the 27th "REC for Kids" will take place at the international cultural centre ufaFabrik, Viktoriastr. 10-18, Berlin.

Out of almost 700 films submitted to the "REC for Kids" and the "REC internationales junges Filmfestival" 69 films from 20 countries will be screened. In addition to the film screenings, exciting workshops, lectures and discussion rounds on animation, radio, steadycam and YouTube will be offered.

From Wednesday to Friday the festival offers from 9am to 1pm programs for children, school classes and young filmmakers. On Saturday at the "Workshop of the Generations" grandparents and their grandchildren can research the subject of cinema film together. At 2 pm a programme with films for the whole family will be shown. The highlight of the festival will be the festive award ceremony at 4 pm, afterwards the award-winning films will be screened again.

Tickets will be available from mid-August at the ufaFabrik.

### **From filmmakers for filmmakers - REC-Filmfestival Berlin**

The REC-Filmfestival Berlin with its two competitions "REC for Kids" for children between the ages of 6-15 years and "REC international young film festival" for young filmmakers between the ages of 16-27 years exists since 1992 (at that time it started as: Youth Media Festival Berlin).

"REC for Kids" does not present films as a mere consumer event, but designs the presentation of the films as a learning process for the young audience. This is achieved through a presentation by an expert host, who will explain the special features of the films and clarify that a film is more than just actors and stars. Additional to the screenings there is the possibility to attend workshops.

A children's jury and a jury of professional filmmakers and media pedagogues will award the golden and silver clips in the respective age groups. In addition, a Doku-Clip as prize will be given for the best documentary film of the "International Leipzig Festival for Documentary and Animated Film".

The REC-Filmfestival Berlin is organized by the non-profit association Puma e.V. with ist media centre Clip, the Outreach gGmbH and the media competence centre "Netti" in Tempelhof-Schöneberg.
